Community Discussion:

- ◆ No community discussion presented

Consent Agenda: *The consent agenda groups routine meeting actions into a single agenda item so they can be approved in one step, rather than in multiple motions.*

- ✓ Minutes of the July 16, 2024, City Council meeting; Chief of Police recommendations for OLCC applications for Grocery Outlet and Pendleton Cigar.

Public Hearings and Related Ordinances and Resolutions

- ✓ Public Hearing on Ordinance 4022, Amending Ordinance 3382, the Dangerous Dog Ordinance: *This revises the dangerous dog ordinance to allow for specific provisions for dogs in the dog park at Til Taylor Park. Changes also include clarifications in dog levels of dangerousness.*

New Business

- ◆ TRT and TPAC Random Drawing for audit: *Each year, the City randomly audits one lodging business. Pendleton Motolodge was drawn this year.*
- ◆ First Reading, Ordinance 4023, amending the lodging room tax, Ordinance 2795: *This changes the appeal process for the lodging tax payers to the City Manager instead of the City Council. No vote is taken on a first reading.*
- ✓ Bid award for the McKennon Road Lift Station Replacement project to Bolen Construction, LLC : *Road Lift Station Replacement project awarded to Bolen Construction, LLC, of Hermiston, Oregon. for \$351,563.00*
- ◆ City Attorney overview on the Supreme Court Decision on Homelessness
- ◆ LOC Legislative Priorities Discussion: *City Council and Mayor John Turner discussed various options on the legislative priorities list provided by the League of Oregon Cities. Each council member will select their priorities and send those to the mayor to determine one priority list for the City of Pendleton to provide to the LOC.*
