 - ◆ Annual Report from Communications Specialist: *Jennifer Colton gave an update on communication efforts for the City of Pendleton and summarized the results of the 2024 Communication Survey.*
-  Final Report for Building Maintenance Funds: *The council action reduces the reporting responsibility on the Finance Department. With this change, funds held in the Building Maintenance Fund #299 will be reported and approved by the department the funding is intended for (without specifying projects). This change has no fiscal impact to the city.*
