



In the future, many envision Pendleton as safe and retaining its small-town charm. Many hope it will be thriving, clean, and vibrant/busy.




What are Pendleton's TOP 3 greatest assets today?

The unhoused/unsheltered, infrastructure, and high cost of housing are the leading concerns amongst constituents.


